

## Modus Operandi ECREA **Digital Communication and Culture** section

### **1. Membership**

1.1. The ECREA Digital Communication and Culture section is constituted by all ECREA-members who join the section.

1.2. ECREA-members can join the section by expressing their interest via e-mail or letter to the chair or by registering at section events.

### **2. Business meeting**

2.1. The section has an annual business meeting, open to all interested ECREA-members. Only section members qualify to vote at the business meeting.

2.2. The section business meeting is the primary decision making body in terms of decisions regarding the general direction of the section and determining current issues to be addressed by the section (with the limitation specified in 2.4).

2.3. The section business meeting can modify the modus operandi and/or the mission statement.

2.4. The section business meeting cannot take decisions that go against the spirit or the general statutes of ECREA and the ECREA Board maintains the ultimate decision powers.

### **3. Section team**

3.1. The section team consists of a chair and two vice-chairs, who are responsible for the day-to-day running of the section.

3.2 Chair and vice-chairs are chosen every two years. The election will take place by mail or via a secret election at the annual business meeting. A simple majority of votes is required. The results will be communicated via e-mail and at the section business meeting.

3.3 Three months before the end of the mandate of the outgoing team, candidates can put themselves forward for election, ideally as a team of three, by sending an e-mail to the chair.

3.4. The section team is accountable for its decisions to the section business meeting and to the ECREA-board.
